## **COTTONWOOD** **Bottom Ledge**

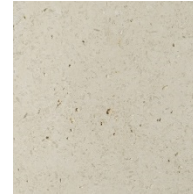


Tighter range and grain structure compared to Top Ledge Cottonwood with cool undertones

Creamy white

*Avg Block Dims*  
18" H X 50" W X 4' to 8" L

## **COTTONWOOD** **Top Ledge**



Slightly warmer in color than Bottom Ledge Cottonwood with a more open grain structure

Yellow tint and creamy gray

*Avg Block Dims*  
36" H X 50" W X 4' to 8" L

## **FLINT HILLS GRAY**



Consistent medium gray color

*Avg Block Dims*  
22" to 24" H X 4' to 5'-6" W X 4' to 6'+ L

## **ONAGA**



Overall warm tone & varying grain structure throughout

Gray, cream, gold & bronze

*Avg Block Dims*  
36" to 48" H X 4' to 5'6" W X 4'-6'+ L

## **PLAZA GRAY**



Dark and medium gray with occasional taupe

*Avg Block Dims*  
22" to 24" H X 4' to 5'-6" W X 4' to 6'+ L

## **PRAIRIE SHELL**



Contains brown shell inclusions which gives stone a patina look

Light cream and gray earth tones

*Avg Block Dims*  
22" to 24" H X 4' to 5'6" W X 4' to 6'+ L

## **SILVERDALE**



Consistent, warm appearance and tight grain structure

Warm cream and buff to yellow tones

*Avg Block Dims*  
28" H X 50" W X 6'+ L
